Dear Sir / Madam,

We live in a rural area and have found that the prices are increasing considerably, we have recently returned from the Netherlands and found that the prices have increased again. We found that the basic food needs in Holland were far cheaper (eg. A loaf of quality bread costs between 1 to 1:30 euros, and fresh milk between 1:50 to 1:80 euros for 2 ltrs). We live in an area with only one major supermarket and when we shop in the city find that the quality is much better especial fresh produce than in our local shop of the same company.

Fuel prices are another story, when fuel in our local town is often 5 to 10 cents dearer than in Port Wakefield even though the fuel is stored locally and transported back to Wakefield. We have only one bus a day, and have no way of getting anywhere without using our own transport.
