

Correction to ACCC Water Monitoring Report 2009-10

The ACCC has discovered that, due to a calculation error, the 2009-10 Water Monitoring Report (the Report) overstated the volume of irrigation right transformed by Murrumbidgee Irrigation.

Murrumbidgee Irrigation customers transformed approximately 39GL of irrigation right over 2009-10, rather than 74GL as stated in the Report (page 118). As this figure went into the ACCC's calculation of the total volume of irrigation right transformed across the Murray-Darling Basin, this figure was also overstated (157GL, rather than 192GL as stated in the Report on pages xiii and 114).

The following affected charts have been amended: 8.2, 8.3 and 8.10 (see below). Please note that chart 8.3 appears twice in the Report (pages xiv and 119). The ACCC apologises for any confusion this may have caused.

Chart 8.2: Irrigation right transformed in 2009-10 – Volume in ML

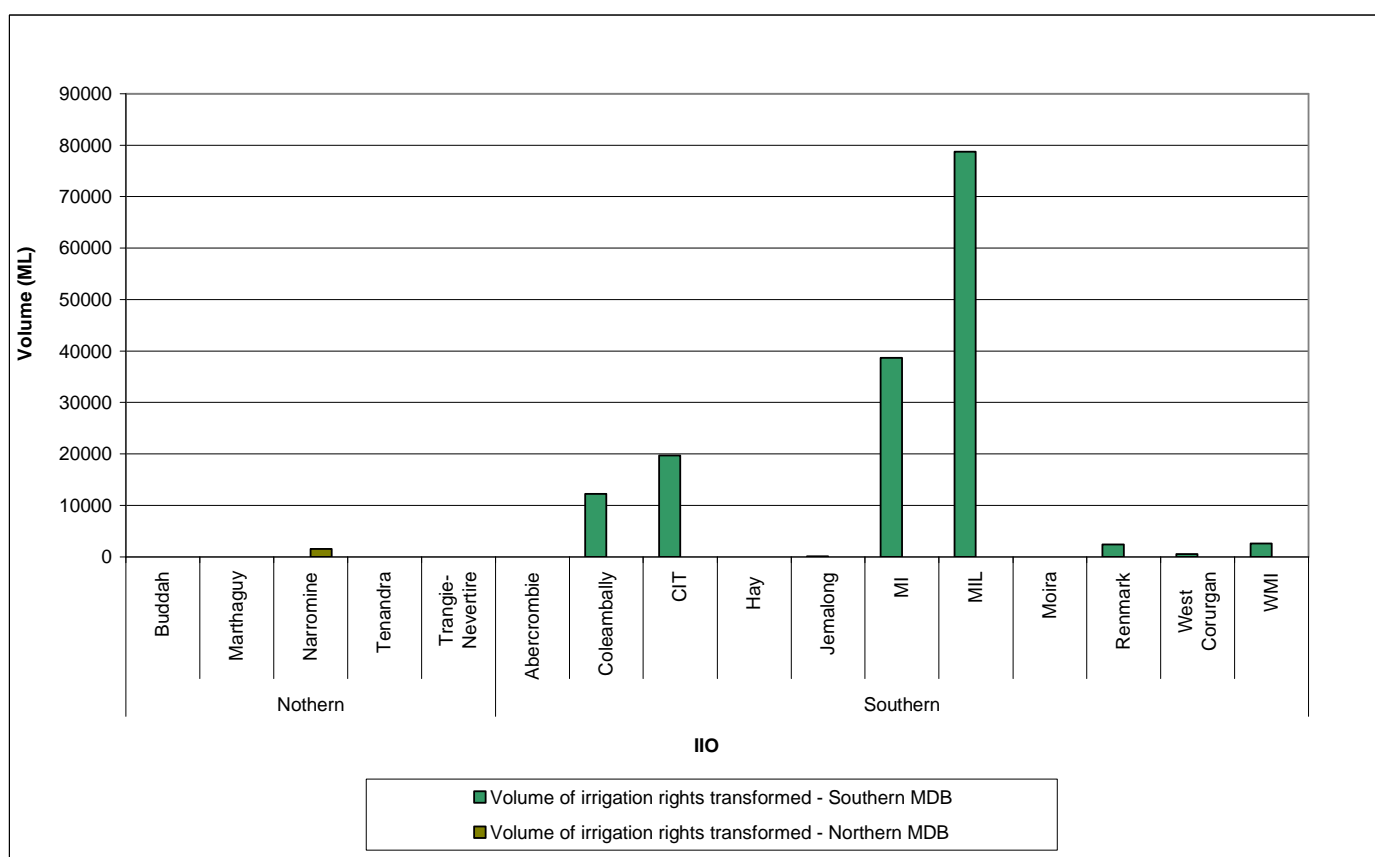


Chart 8.3: Irrigation right transformed in 2009-10 as a percentage of total irrigation right 1 July 2009

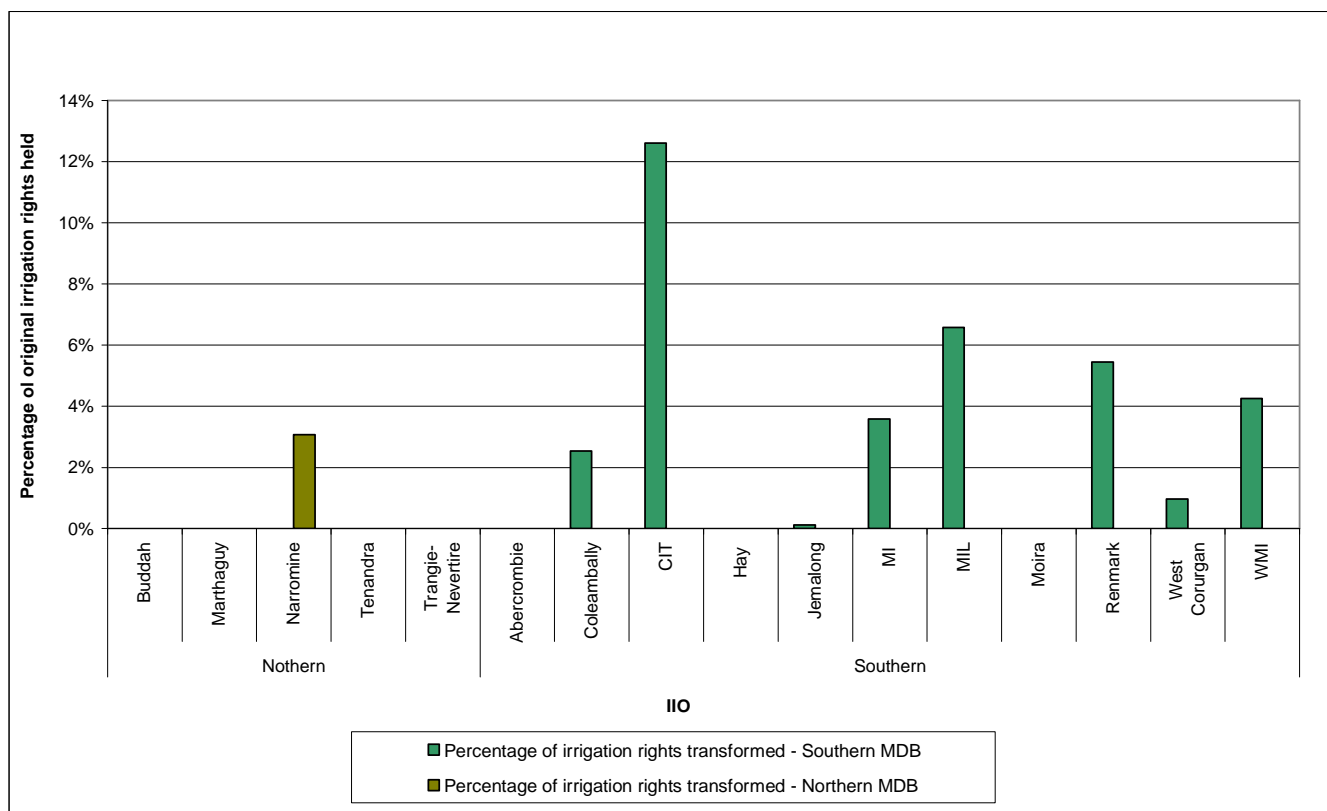


Chart 8.10: Volume of water delivery right terminated by transforming customers, per ML of irrigation right transformed in 2009-10
