**Expected period for consideration of Viterra Operations Limited's proposed
Port Terminal Services Access Undertaking**

Thank you for your letter of 20 June 2011 seeking the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission's (ACCC) agreement to stop the clock for the consideration and decision on Viterra Operations Limited's (Viterra) proposed access undertaking. Viterra has proposed that the clock be stopped from 20 June 2011 to 8 July 2011 (inclusive).

The ACCC agrees to Viterra's request. The calculation of time in working out the 'expected period' under section 44ZZBC(1) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth) will restart on 9 July 2011.
