Variation to Telstra's Migration Plan

I enclose for your consideration Telstra's proposed variations to the Migration Plan. Telstra requests approval from the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC) for the enclosed variations to the Migration Plan as allowed under section 577BF of the *Telecommunications Act 1997* (Cth).

As discussed with the ACCC, the key changes in the variations to the Migration Plan relate to the arrangements for In-Train Orders (which are proposed to apply for two years from 1 July 2016) and to the disconnection arrangements for Direct Special Services and Special Service Inputs. We would welcome the opportunity to take the ACCC through the proposed amendments to the Migration Plan by telephone this week if that would be of assistance.

A detailed supporting public submission on our Varied Migration Plan is enclosed to describe and explain the amendments to the Varied Migration Plan. We note that NBN Co approves of the proposed variations.

Our Varied Migration Plan is provided to you in both 'clean' and 'marked up' versions to assist with your review and consultation process. The 'marked up' version shows all changes made from the current Migration Plan (as approved by the ACCC on 26 June 2015).
