## Form of notices under section 151ZB of the *Telecommunications Act* 1997

For the purposes of subsection 151ZB(2) of the *Telecommunications Act 1997,* a notification given pursuant to subsection 151ZB(1) must:

- be in writing;
- identify the person (other than the 'first person') mentioned at subparagraph 151ZB(1)(b)(i) or (ii);
- describe the relevant event mentioned at paragraph 151ZB(1)(c);
- specify the date the relevant change in control event mentioned at subparagraph 151ZB(1)(b)(i) or (ii) took place; and
- be submitted electronically to the ACCC in an accessible format.

For the purposes of subsection 151ZB(4) of the *Telecommunications Act 1997,* a notification made pursuant to subsection 151ZB(3) must:

- be in writing;
- identify the persons mentioned at paragraphs 151ZB(3)(a) and (b);
- describe the position specified at paragraph 151ZB(3)(c);
- specify the date of change in control of the person who gave the functional separation undertaking; and
- be submitted electronically to the ACCC in an accessible format.

Note: The term "person" in these forms has been used for consistency with the requirements of subsections 151ZB(1) and (3) of the *Telecommunications Act 1997* (Telecommunications Act). It is noted, however, that pursuant to subsection 2C(1) of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901*, references to a "person" in any Act include a "body corporate" and that only a corporation (as defined in section 142A of the Telecommunications Act to mean "a body corporate") can give a functional separation undertaking.
