[REDACTED] is in my view engaging in corporate predatory practice viz exercising a exploitative monopoly in its pricing.

Here in Adelaide I have to pay about 36c per KWh for the power I draw ie after sun loss, yet [REDACTED] only pay me 16 per KWh for power I put out to the grid when my solar panels are generating. And until recently [REDACTED] paid only 8c per KWh!

Despite doubling the rebate rate, I believe that the current difference of 20c per KWh is still a rip off. Does it really cost 20c to redistribute each KWh? Especially when [REDACTED] benefit hugely during high demand times from what for them is cheap power by underpaying and gouging many small producers.

And I already and also pay a substantial charge for the poles and wires service!

I would be happy to forward a copy of my current power bill.

Please step in and rein in this blatant corporate greed.
