Subject: Exorbitant electricity price increase.

Dear inquiry members,

I have just finished reading an article in the Merimbula (NSW) regional newspaper Friday 28th July 2017 regarding increased power charges. I would like to add my voice to all the people who are disgusted with this latest huge price increase to our electricity.

Since I moved here just over 10 years my usage charge per kw. has increased from 0.22cents to 0.36cents. The daily supply charge has increased from 0.62cents to \$1.485 per day! So, currently \$133.60 is charged for the supply of electricity for 90 days.

The rebate of 0.06cents 'given back' for my solar input has not increased since I installed it in July 2013.

Well, I certainly hope you all can bring these 'powers that be' that have made electricity a luxury to account.

I for one will be moving to Qld where at least I will not have to suffer exorbitant winter heating bills.
