Notice of extension of decision-making period for making a decision to accept or reject a Special Access Undertaking under subsection 152CBC(7)

- Pursuant to subsection 152CBC(7) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (Commission) extends the period for making a decision to accept or reject the 18 December 2012 Special Access Undertaking (the SAU) given by NBN Co Limited (ACN 136 533 741) and NBN Tasmania Limited (ACN 138 338 271) (together NBN Co) by three months.
- The Commission has been unable to make a decision on the SAU within the 6-month period referred to in subsection 152CBC(5) due to the volume and nature of the submissions received in response to the Commission's April 2013 Draft Decision on the SAU and the Consultation Paper on the variation of the SAU.

Note: NBN Co Limited and NBN Tasmania Limited gave the SAU to the Commission on 18 December 2012. On 19 December 2012, the Commission published the SAU pursuant to subsection 152CBD(2) and invited people to make submissions by 18 January 2013.
