I was appointed liquidator of Infinity on 26 September 2013.

I refer to your correspondence of 13 April 2015 and apologise for the delay in responding to same.

In reference to your correspondence of 13 April 2015, the **Infinity information** was provided to the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission ("ACCC") on 11 March 2014 as a result of the Notice to Produce ('Notice') served on 13 February 2013, pursuant to section 133D of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* and related schedules. Noncompliance with said Notice was an offence.

With reference to my letter of 11 March 2014, I consider my responses to questions 1 to 4 and 6 of Schedule 1, and questions 1, 3, 4 and 6 of Schedule 2 were factual in nature and did not include any confidential and/ or personal information.

The exceptions to this include my responses to question 4 of Schedule 1, and questions 2 and 5 of Schedule 2. In this regard I request that you treat the names of any individuals and/ or reports and correspondences from a third party as being personal and confidential in nature.

I have no reason to suspect that the **disclosed information** of 2 April 2015, as detailed in your correspondence of 13 April 2015, was private or confidential in nature.

It may be prudent that the ACCC obtains its own legal advice in relation to disclosure of the material in its possession obtained from me as a result of the Notice.
