

ttem Number 3170976 (HSUM006SB) -- 4 burner hooded bbq with steel cabinet & side burner -- \$198.00 current range



Item Number 3170544 (model HSGG008D) - 4 burner flat top hot plate bbq with steel trolley - deleted product



So the last incident refers to Item Number 3170544 (above) – 4 burner flat top hot plate bbq with steel trolley – which is a deleted product (AGA certificate attached).

The alleged injury was partial thickness burns to customer's lower limbs.

The hospital lists the cause of the incident as hot oil from BBQ hitting eg.

It appears the customer didn't maintain bod and didn't regularly empty the oil collected in the drip compartment
