

Notice of consultation on Telstra's proposed variations to its Final Migration Plan

This is a notice under paragraph 577BF(4)(a) of the *Telecommunications Act 1997*.

The ACCC has received a request from Telstra to vary its Final Migration Plan (Migration Plan) as follows:

- Streamline Telstra's existing reporting and disclosure requirements associated with the Migration plan. This includes replacing quarterly reporting with simplified annual reporting arrangements and removing the requirement to collect and report on the results of the performance measures and metrics under the Plan (Clauses 26.1 and 26.2 and Schedules 3 & 7).
- Clarify that the role of the Director of Equivalence will cease to exist to align with proposed variations to the Structural Separation Undertaking (Clause 28).
- Amend the Migration Plan to continue Telstra's disconnection arrangement for the In-Train Order Premises (Clauses 15.1A & 15.1 and Schedules 3 & 10)

Persons are invited to make submissions about the variations to the final migration plan within 28 days after this notice is published, **by 14 May 2025**. Submissions can be made via email to ssu-migration@accc.gov.au. All submissions will be published on the ACCC website.
