**Transport Workers Union of Australia SA/NT Branch – collective bargaining application for authorisation A91589 (Whyalla) – final determination**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has issued a determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by the Transport Workers Union of Australia SA/NT Branch (the **TWU**) on 27 June 2017.

The TWU sought authorisation for owner drivers who are contracted to Toll Transport Pty Ltd (**Toll**) to collectively bargain with Toll, with assistance from the TWU, to establish new contracts for the supply of freight courier and haulier services in the Whyalla region of South Australia.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached, including a summary of its reasons. For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant authorisation for 5 years.

**Application for review**

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the **Tribunal**) for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 14 December 2017. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 15 December 2017.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Tribunal. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
