Qantas Limited and Jetstar Pty Ltd application for revocation of authorisations A91314 & A91315 and substitution of new authorisations A91600 & A91601 – final determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination in respect of the application for re-authorisation lodged on 12 September 2017.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached. For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to re-authorise the arrangements until 31 March 2023.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the Tribunal) for a review of the determination. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before **9 March 2018**. If no application for a review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on **10 March 2018**.

An application for a review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Tribunal. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
