## Qantas Airways Limited & Emirates application for revocation of authorisations A91332 and A921333 and substitution of new authorisation AA1000400 – determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has issued a determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by Qantas Airways Limited (**Qantas**) and Emirates on 11 October 2017. A copy of the ACCC's determination and summary of its reasons is attached.

For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC grants authorisation, subject to a condition, for five years. Under section 88(3) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (the **Act**), the legal protection afforded by the authorisation does not apply if the condition is not complied with.

The ACCC also grants interim authorisation, with effect from 31 March 2018.

## Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the Act, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the Tribunal) for a review of the determination. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 13 April 2018. If no application for a review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on **14 April 2018**.

An application for a review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Tribunal. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
