By way of background, on the 26th April 2018 AORA made a submission to the ACCC on this issue and on the 27th April, AORA National Chair, Peter Wadewitz confirmed to you via email that our submission could be placed on the ACCC Public Register.

I have been able to only review the report summary. The summarised findings, consideration of industry views and decision at the start of the report are noted but AORA have not had sufficient time to review the report in detail or to consult with those potentially impacted amongst our membership.

We note that in Paragraph 212 of the report that "The ACCC now seeks submissions in response to this draft determination. In addition, consistent with section 90A of the Act, the applicant or an interested party may request that the ACCC hold a conference to discuss the draft determination."

We would request an extension in providing a submission until the end of the month and also request that the ACCC hold a conference to discuss this determination.
