Council Solutions' application for authorisation AA1000414, collection services – draft determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has issued a draft determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by Council Solutions on 14 March 2018.

Council Solutions, on behalf of the Cities of Adelaide, Charles Sturt, Marion and Port Adelaide Enfield (Participating Councils), seeks authorisation to jointly procure the collection of domestic waste, recyclables and organics through the utilisation of a 3-Bin system, including the supply and maintenance of mobile garbage bins, through a collaborative competitive tender process.

For the reasons set out in its draft determination, the ACCC proposes to grant authorisation until 30 June 2031. The ACCC has also granted interim authorisation to allow the councils to commence the tender process, but not enter into any waste collection contracts. A copy of the ACCC's draft determination is attached.

This application for authorisation is for collection services only. Council Solutions has submitted further applications for authorisation for separate request for tenders for processing service streams and ancillary service streams. The ACCC expects to release draft determinations in relation to these applications in August 2018.

Next steps

Once the ACCC issues a draft determination, the Applicants or any interested party may make a written submission and/or request that the ACCC convene a 'pre-decision conference'.

If you wish to make a submission in response to the ACCC's draft determination, please lodge your submission by **3 August 2018**. Submissions should be emailed to adjudication@accc.gov.au with the subject "AA1000414 – Council Solutions – submission".

A pre-decision conference provides the opportunity for interested parties to make oral submissions in relation to the draft determination. Conferences are conducted informally and while legal or professional advisers are able to attend they are not entitled to participate in the discussion.

If you wish the ACCC to hold a pre-decision conference in relation to the draft determination you must notify the ACCC in writing by **3 August 2018**.

The ACCC will consider any submissions it receives, including any oral submissions made should a pre-decision conference be called, and will then release a final determination in relation to this application.

Submissions will be placed on the ACCC's public register subject to any request for exclusion. Please see the publication <u>Guidelines for excluding information from the public register.</u>

The ACCC will progress its assessment of the application in a timely manner. An indicative timetable is set out below for your information:
