On 21 May 2018 the ACCC received a confidential submission supporting the Homeworke Code Committee’s application AA1000418. The submission noted that Ethical Clothing Australia is an important organisation that supports the local textile, clothing and footwear industry, its employees and businesses that are manufacturing in Australia and that it is important to have independent, third-party accreditation that allows their business to demonstrate their compliance with the relevant workplace laws in Australia.
