## APPLICATION FOR AUTHORISATION (AA1000428) - CAMPBELLTOWN CITY COUNCIL and ORS

The Applicants wish to amend application AA1000428 to also seek authorisation for the Councils of Camden, Campbelltown, Wingecarribee and Wollondilly to continue to engage in the conduct authorised by the ACCC under application for authorisation A90886 from the expiry date of A90886 until the end of the current contract with Suez Australia on 31 May 2024.

The Councils were of the view that Authorisation A90886 expired 15 years after commencement of waste processing services which started on 1 June 2009. However, upon closer examination of the wording of the current Authorisation it was confirmed that the 15 year period commences from the date contracts were entered into.

It is therefore respectfully requested that the original authorisation A90886 be amended to expire 31 May 2024 in order that the Councils have authorisation coverage for the entire length of the processing/disposal contract period. No objections are raised to this information being placed on the ACCC public register.
