Look where the money goes. Peanut butter sandwiches and air conditioning are expensive and important. The giant industrial Moneywashing Maytag that IS THE APRA POOL.. I don't get a decent dip in it and .. even if I Were to be crowned and win the wet T-shirt competition it would be sweat, debt and pride that made it happen, not Royalties. Even when my stuff is played, I'm not counted so I WILL NEVER GET TO VOTE, unless I use my lunch money to go play gigs.

Seems pretty irresponsible to me. Music is not free to the musicians...we bleed for it.

APRA needs more than a bandaid, it needs looking at In Public.. let us share in the money from the pool even if we Aren't getting counted could not this Huge Agency Pay a subsistence allowance to its writer membership it's A GIANT POOL. Let us piss in it, also.. thanks.
