## The Uniting Church in Australia National Assembly (UCANA) Application for authorisation AA1000447— final determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a final determination in respect of the above application.

The ACCC's determination grants authorisation to UCANA, the Relevant Synods and other entities that comprise the UCA to collectively negotiate, procure and maintain insurance products and services, until 20 November 2025.

## Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the Competition and Consumer Act 2010, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 20 November 2019. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 21 November 2019.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal, which is a separate body to the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
