Determination - BP Rewards, Qantas Frequent Flyer and Qantas Business Rewards loyalty programs - application for authorisation AA1000452

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has issued a determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by lodged by BP, resellers of fuel under the BP brand (BP Resellers), Qantas Airways Limited and Qantas Frequent Flyer Limited (the Applicants) on 5 September 2019.

The ACCC has decided to grant authorisation until 20 March 2025 to allow the Applicants to collectively participate in the BP Rewards, Qantas Frequent Flyer and Qantas Business Rewards programs.

A copy of the ACCC's determination and summary of reasons is **attached** and also available on the ACCC's authorisations public register.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 19 March 2020. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 20 March 2020.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
