**Office of Liquor and Gaming Regulation application for re-authorisation
AA1000456—final determination**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has issued a determination in respect of the application for re-authorisation lodged by the Office of Liquor and Gaming Regulation on 5 November 2019 regarding liquor accords in Queensland.

For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has granted re-authorisation for current and future liquor accord and Safe Night Precinct local board members to make liquor accord agreements that adopt a provision contained in Section 1 of the pro-forma liquor agreement. The ACCC has granted re-authorisation for five years, until 30 April 2025.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached, including a summary of its reasons, and is also available on the ACCC's [Authorisations Public Register](#).

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 29 April 2020. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 30 April 2020.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
