**Brenntag Australia Pty Ltd - application for revocation of authorisation
AA1000598 and substitution of authorisation AA1000622 - Final determination**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by Brenntag Australia Pty Ltd on 21 October 2022.

Brenntag Australia Pty Ltd sought authorisation for the DEF Supplier Working Group to collaborate, in conjunction with the Australian Government, for specified purposes related to securing sufficient supply of technical grade urea and prioritising access to technical grade urea and diesel exhaust fluid.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached, including a summary of its reasons. It is also available on the ACCC's [authorisations public register](#). For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant authorisation until 3 November 2027.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth), a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 2 November 2023. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 3 November 2023.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
