**Northern Territory of Australia as represented by the Department of Health – application for authorisation AA1000499 - final determination**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has issued a determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by the Northern Territory of Australia as represented by the Department of Health on 15 April 2020.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached and also available on the ACCC's authorisations public register.

For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant conditional authorisation until 30 September 2021.

**Application for review**

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the **Tribunal**) for a review of the determination. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 3 September 2020. If no application for a review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 4 September 2020.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Tribunal. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
