7-Eleven Stores Pty Limited application for authorisation A1000547— interim authorisation decision, initial consultation and public register exclusion request

Interim authorisation

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has decided to grant interim authorisation in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by 7-Eleven Stores Pty Limited (**7-Eleven**) on 11 March 2021. A copy of the ACCC decision is attached.

Interim authorisation protects the arrangements for which authorisation is sought from legal action under the relevant provisions of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth) while the ACCC considers and evaluates the merits of the application.

Next steps

For your information, the next step in the process is for the ACCC to conduct its initial consultation and then prepare a draft determination which will take account of any submissions from 7-Eleven and interested parties and will indicate the ACCC's preliminary views on the merits of the application. The ACCC will give both 7-Eleven and interested parties the opportunity to provide a further submission on the draft determination before the ACCC issues its final decision.

As noted in the attached decision, the ACCC may review its decision on interim authorisation at any time. The ACCC's decision in relation to interim authorisation should not be taken to be indicative of whether or not final authorisation will be granted by the ACCC.
