We wanted to draw your attention to the applications made by state and territory governments for authorisation to engage in certain conduct for the purpose of maximising hospital capacity during the COVID-19 pandemic.

In each case, urgent interim authorisation has been granted. The public register provides links to the applications and the interim authorisation decisions.
