AusPayNet application for revocation of authorisation A91497 and A91498 and substitution of AA1000495 – interested party consultation

On 6 April 2020, the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) received an application for re-authorisation from Australian Payments Network Limited (**AusPayNet**) (formerly the Australian Payments Clearing Association) (revocation and substitution). This letter is to invite you to comment. You are welcome to pass this letter on to others who may wish to make submissions.

AusPayNet is seeking re-authorisation¹ under the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth) (the **Act**). Re-authorisation would give it legal protection in respect of the certification, suspension and termination provisions of the Issuers and Acquirers Community (**IAC**) Regulations (the **Regulations**) and IAC Code Set (the **Code**). The IAC framework governs ATM, EFTPOS and other card payments and settlements. AusPayNet has applied for authorisation for five years. Re-authorisation is sought because an existing authorisation for the arrangements expires on 22 September 2020. A full copy of the application for reauthorisation is available on the ACCC's <u>authorisations public register</u>.

Making a submission

The ACCC invites you to make a submission on the application for re-authorisation. In making your submission, please provide information, evidence and views about the likely public benefits, effects on competition and any other public detriment that you consider will result from the proposed conduct.

If you intend to provide a submission, please do so by **7 May 2020**. If you wish to request an extension, please contact us on the details below as early as possible. Submissions after the due date (or after any extension granted) may not be taken into account.

Please use the coversheet that accompanied this letter and email your submission to adjudication@accc.gov.au, with the subject 'AA1000495 – AusPayNet – submission'. Alternatively, if you would like to provide comments orally, please contact Tanya Hobbs via the details at the end of this letter.

Your submission **will** be placed on the ACCC's <u>authorisations public register on the internet</u> unless you have made a request (with reasons) for us to exclude part or all of the
