Toowoomba City Council Community Airport Incorporated – RN10000456 – Notification of collective bargaining

On 8 October 2024, the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) received a notification from Toowoomba City Council Community Airport Incorporated (**TCCAI**) on behalf of a group of tenants (the **Tenants**) of the Toowoomba City Aerodrome (the **Aerodrome**).

TCCAI intends to negotiate with Toowoomba Regional Council regarding common lease terms to apply to use of the Aerodrome by the Tenants. A full copy of the notification is available on the ACCC's [public register](#). The Notified Conduct does not involve a collective boycott, and is proposed for a period of 10 years.

Legal protection commenced 14 days after the notification was validly lodged, being 22 October 2024. The ACCC may revoke the protection afforded by this notification if it is satisfied that the benefits of the conduct do not outweigh the detriments. Making a submission

As a potentially interested party, the ACCC invites you to make a submission on the notification. In making your submission, please provide information, evidence and views about the likely public benefits, effects on competition and any other public detriment that you consider will result from the notified conduct.
