## Collective bargaining notification CB10000481-1 lodged by the Australian Vending Buying Association – interested party consultation

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) is seeking comments on a collective bargaining notification received from the Australian Vending Buying Association (**AVBA**) on 8 June 2021. The AVBA proposes to collectively negotiate buying agreements on behalf of its current and future members with current and future suppliers of goods supplied into unattended retail points such as micro-markets, vending machines and unattended retail solutions.

A copy of the notification is available from the <u>ACCC's public register</u>.

The purpose of this letter is to invite your comments as a party who may be interested in providing a submission to the ACCC in relation to these arrangements.

## Collective bargaining and the notification process

Collective bargaining occurs when two or more competitors come together to negotiate terms and conditions (including prices) with a supplier or customer.

Without the legal protection provided by a collective bargaining notification, these arrangements can breach the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (**the Act**).

The legal protection provided by a collective bargaining notification commences 14 days after the notification is lodged, unless the ACCC objects within this period.

## **Request for submissions**

When the ACCC receives a collective bargaining notification it will assess the likely public benefits and detriments, including any lessening of competition, to determine whether it should object to the notification.

You are invited to comment on the likely public benefits and likely effect on competition, or any other public detriment, from AVBA's proposed collective bargaining arrangements. Submissions should be provided by close of business **21 June 2021**. Submissions should be emailed to <a href="mailto:exemptions@accc.gov.au">exemptions@accc.gov.au</a> with the subject "CB10000481-1 – AVBA – submission".

Submissions received by the ACCC will be placed on a public register, subject to any request for exclusion. Please see the ACCC's publication <u>Guidelines for excluding information from the public register</u>.
