Racing and Wagering Western Australia (RWWA) application for minor variation [AA1000423]— determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination in respect of the application for minor variation lodged by RWWA on 14 February 2020.

RWWA requested a minor variation of the authorisation in anticipation of the sale by the Western Australian Government of the wagering business conducted by RWWA.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is available on [the public register](#), including a summary of its reasons. For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant the minor variation. The ACCC's assessment is set out in Chapter four of its determination.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 29 April 2020. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 30 April 2020.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
