Australian Institute of Petroleum application for authorisation AA1000488 — draft determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (**ACCC**) has issued a draft determination that proposes to grant conditional authorisation for 6 months to enable the Australian Institute of Petroleum, its members, and any future parties approved by the ACCC to cooperate on ensuring the security of supply of fuel products to Australian businesses and consumers during the COVID-19 pandemic.

A copy of the ACCC's draft determination is available on the <u>public register</u>. The ACCC is seeking feedback from interested parties on the draft determination.

Next steps

Once the ACCC issues a draft determination, an applicant or any interested party may make a written submission and/or request that the ACCC convene a 'pre-decision conference'.

A pre-decision conference provides the opportunity for interested parties to make oral submissions in relation to the draft determination. Conferences are conducted informally and while legal or professional advisers are able to attend they are not entitled to participate in the discussion.

If you wish to request a pre-decision conference in relation to the draft determination, please notify the ACCC in writing by **14 August 2020**.

If you wish to make a written submission in response to the draft determination, please lodge your submission by **14 August 2020**.

Submissions will be placed on the ACCC's public register, subject to any request for exclusion. Please see the ACCC's <u>Guidelines for excluding information from the public register</u> for further information on how to make a request.

The ACCC will consider any submissions it receives, including any oral submissions made at a pre-decision conference (should one be called), and will then release a final determination in relation to this application.

Timetable

The ACCC will continue to progress its assessment of the application in a timely manner. An updated indicative timetable is set out below for your information.
