**Hunter Valley Coal Chain Coordinator Limited - application for authorisation
AA1000658 – Determination**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by Hunter Valley Coal Chain Coordinator (HVCCC) on 19 December 2023.

For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC grants authorisation for 10 years, until 31 December 2034.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth), a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 26 June 2024. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 27 June 2024.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
