**Gateway Network Governance Body Limited application for authorisation AA1000552  
— final determination**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has issued a final determination in respect of the application for re-authorisation lodged by Gateway Network Governance Body Limited (**GNGB**) on 29 April 2021.

GNGB sought re-authorisation to enable it to continue to make and give effect to certain clauses of the revised Memorandum of Understanding between itself and Gateway Operators, concerning the stewardship arrangements for the Superannuation Transaction Network.

For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant authorisation for 10 years, until 28 October 2031.

**Application for review**

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth), a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 27 October 2021. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 28 October 2021.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
