Steeline Members Pty Ltd application for authorisation – AA1000520 – final determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC) has issued a final determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by Steeline Members Pty Ltd (Steeline) on behalf of its self and its current and future members, on 25 June 2020.

For the reasons set out in its final determination, the ACCC has decided to grant conditional authorisation for five years. The ACCC has decided to impose a condition of authorisation requiring Steeline to advise the ACCC 14 days in advance of a new member joining the group.

A copy of the final determination is attached and available on the ACCC's public register.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the Competition and Consumer Act 2010, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 23 December 2020. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into effect on the 24 December 2020.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
