### **WA Primary Health Alliance Ltd application for authorisation AA1000577 — final determination**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has issued a final determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by WA Primary Health Alliance Ltd (**WAPHA**) on behalf of itself and other organisations responsible for the Primary Health Networks (**PHNs**) on 14 September 2021.

The ACCC has authorised WAPHA and the Participating PHNs to jointly develop their own data extraction software tool, known as Primary Sense 2. The authorisation also allows WAPHA to enter into and give effect to contracts with the Participating PHNs to provide support services relating to Primary Sense 2.

For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant authorisation until 19 March 2027.

### **Application for review**

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth), a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 18 March 2022. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 19 March 2022.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
