Boral Cement Limited – application for re-authorisation AA1000517 — final determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has issued a final determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by Boral Cement Limited (**Boral Cement**) on 3 June 2020.

For the reasons set out in its final determination, the ACCC has decided to grant authorisation subject to a condition for five years.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 17 December 2020. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into effect on the OOMA Offtake Commencement Date (which is when all the conditions of the OOMA have been satisfied or waived).

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
