Eastern Metropolitan Regional Council & Ors – application for authorisation AA1000587 – final determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has issued a determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by the Eastern Metropolitan Regional Council (**EMRC**), the City of Bayswater, the Town of Bassendean and the Shire of Mundaring on 1 November 2021.

For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant authorisation until 30 June 2033.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached, and available on the ACCC's Authorisations public register.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth), a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 17 June 2022. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 18 June 2022.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
