**Qantas Airways Limited & China Eastern Airlines Corporation Limited
application for authorisation AA1000526 – Final determination**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has issued a determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by Qantas Airways Limited & China Eastern Airlines Corporation Limited on 31 July 2020.

The ACCC's determination grants authorisation for the applicants to cooperate in relation to services between Australia and China until 31 March 2023.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the Competition and Consumer Act 2010, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 19 February 2021.

If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 20 February 2021. An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
