CB10000477 – KIS Transport Australia Pty Ltd – No further action

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has assessed the collective bargaining notification CB10000477 lodged by KIS Transport Australia Pty Ltd (**KIS Transport**) on 21 December 2020. The protection from legal action provided by this notification commenced on 4 January 2021.

In addition, the ACCC has decided that it is appropriate for the notification to remain in force for six years until 20 December 2026. The ACCC's Statement of Reasons is available on [the public register](#).

Application for review

Under section 101A of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth) (the **Act**), a person dissatisfied with the ACCC's decision in relation to the period of the notification may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the **Tribunal**) for a review of that decision. An application for review must be made to the Tribunal on or before 14 May 2021. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia. The ACCC may review a notification at any time if circumstances change, or the ACCC receives further information, such that it is satisfied that the public benefits no longer outweigh the public detriments.
