RE: Resale Price Maintenance (RPM) notification RPN10000455 lodged by Stanley Black & Decker Australia Pty Ltd (SBD) - Final Notice

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has decided to issue the attached final notice to SBD in relation to SBD's RPM notification lodged with the ACCC on 17 October 2019. The effect of this notice is to revoke the RPM notification on 5 July 2020.

Under the notification, SBD proposes to stipulate a minimum advertised price (MAP) for Dewalt branded power tools, accessories and attachments (the Notified Conduct).

From 5 July 2020, SBD does not have statutory protection from legal action to engage in the Notified Conduct.

Application for review

Issuing a notice revoking a notification is subject to review by the Australian Competition Tribunal. A person seeking review must lodge an application for review with the Tribunal within 21 days of the ACCC issuing the notice.

An application for a review of the ACCC's decision should be lodged directly with the Tribunal.

The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
