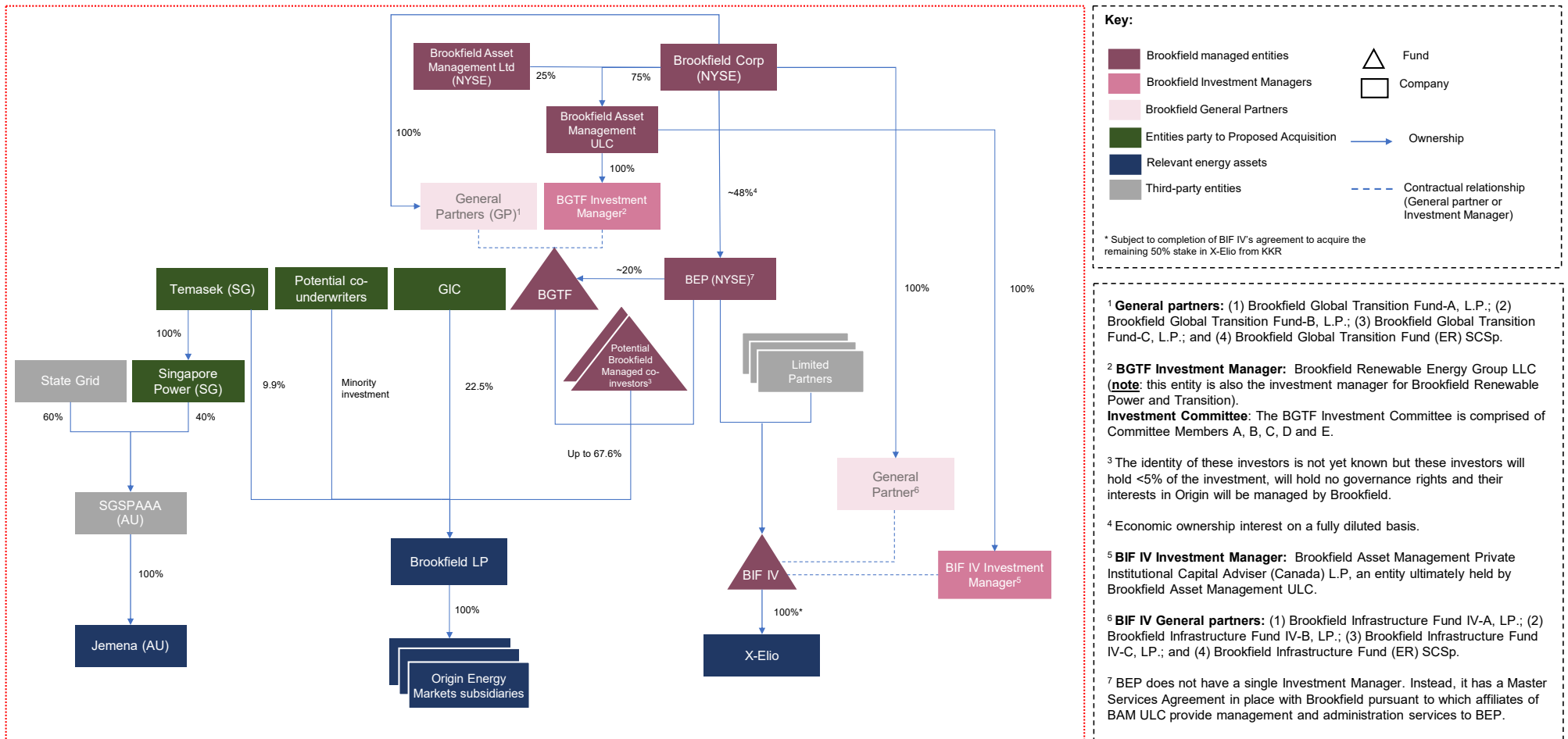
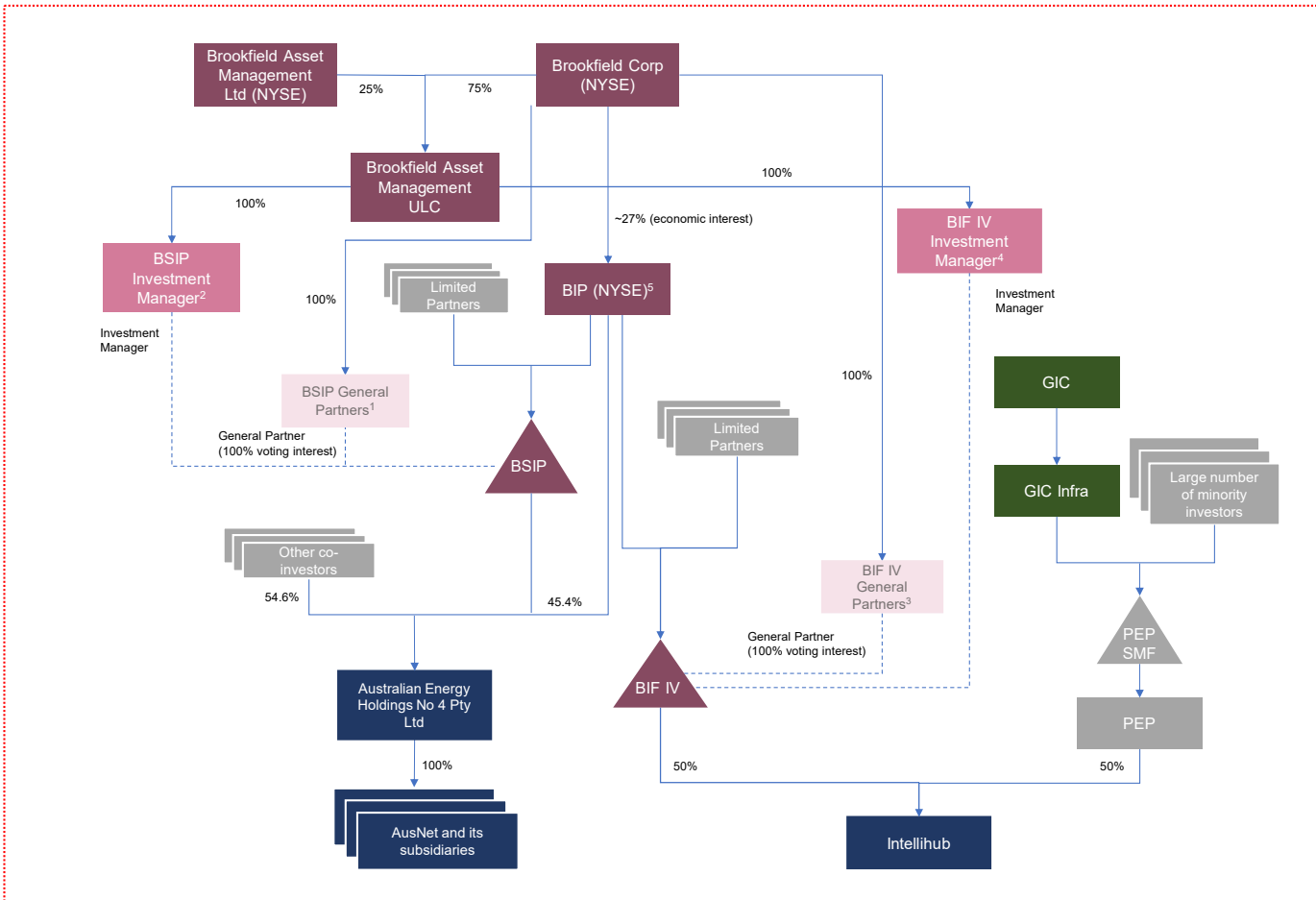


Post-Acquisition structure chart (Energy Markets)
