In further reviewing the application, there is a question we wanted to clarify regarding the conduct that CEC is seeking authorisation for. Section 4.1 of the application says:

The CEC are seeking authorisation, on behalf of themselves and future signatories to the Solar Retailer Code, to agree, sign up to and comply with provisions of the Code.

'Current signatories' are omitted from this description, but elsewhere, it says "All signatories to the Code of Conduct are parties to the authorisation" (s 2.2). Could you just confirm that the CEC is also seeking authorisation for current signatories?
