Private Healthcare Australia Limited | Withdrawal of application for revocation of AA1000487 and substitution of authorisation AA1000545

We refer to the interim authorisation decision issued by the ACCC on 30 March 2021 (**Interim Authorisation**) in relation to Private Healthcare Australia Limited's (**PHA**) application for revocation of AA1000487 and substitution of authorisation AA1000545 (**Application**).

The ACCC has issued the Interim Authorisation to enable the Participating Parties to engage in the Proposed Conduct while the ACCC considers the substantive Application for re-authorisation. However, **PHA seeks to withdraw its Application** in accordance with section 91C(8) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth), on the basis that the Interim Authorisation denied the parties' request to engage in the expanded forms of Proposed Conduct.
