**Notifications of Exclusive Dealing – PlesTel Pty Limited
N31041 and N31086**

The above notifications were lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the Commission) on 16 October 2000 and 21 December 2000 and have been placed on the Commission's public register. Legal immunity provided by the third line forcing provisions of the Trade Practices Act came into force 29 October 2000 and 3 January 2001 respectively.

On the basis of the information that you have provided, I have decided not to make inquiries at this time concerning the notified conduct.

Please note that the Commission may act to remove the immunity afforded by these notifications at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.

The Commission has received your cheques each for \$1,000 being lodgement fees for N31041 and N31086. The correct fee for the lodgement of a notification of third line forcing conduct by an individual or a proprietary company is \$100. I therefore enclose two cheques for \$900 being reimbursement for overpayment of your lodgement fees.
