**Notification of Exclusive Dealing – Fantastic Furniture
N31094**

The above notification was lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the Commission) on 8 February 2001 and has been placed on the Commission's public register. Legal immunity provided by the third line forcing provisions of the Trade Practices Act came into force on 22 February 2001.

On the basis of the information that you have provided, I have decided not to make inquiries at this time concerning the notified conduct.

Please note that the Commission may act to remove the immunity afforded by this notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.

The Commission has received your cheque for \$1,000 being the lodgement fee for N31094. The correct fee for the lodgement of a notification of third line forcing conduct by an individual or a proprietary company is \$100. I therefore enclose a cheque for \$900 being reimbursement for overpayment of your lodgement fee.
