RE: Notification of Exclusive Dealing
The Royal Automobile Club of Queensland



We wish to make notification to the Commission in relation to a proposed course of conduct involving a benefit to be provided to RACQ members.

Broadly, this proposal involves a range of discounts, subject to change, to be offered to members who have a monitored security system installed through RACQ Security Services.

By way of background, we advise that RACQ Security Services is a domestic and commercial alarm monitoring service operated by Signature Security Systems Pty Ltd through an alliance agreement between RACQ and Signature Security Systems.

RACQ Security Services was previously operated by All-States Security Services which was created out of a joint venture agreement between RACQ, GIO Australia and the Royal Automobile Association of South Australia. This year, an alliance agreement and service level agreement was entered into with Signature Security Services for the continued operation of the RACQ Security Services product.

Specifically, the proposal is to offer RACQ members special packages and benefits and/or discounts on the installation and monitoring of RACQ Security Services home security systems. As an example, a possible offer to be made to members may comprise a saving of \$75 on the installation and 17% per month on monitoring on a 2 year contract taken out by the member with Signature Security Systems.

It is intended to offer the member benefits and/or discounts to members via advertisements published in the Club magazine, The Road Ahead.

As different offers may be made at various times, if required, RACQ will advise the Commission in writing should the discount levels or benefits to be offered, change.

Please find **enclosed** the Form G in relation to the proposal together with our cheque in the sum of \$1,000 being the applicable fee for the notification.
