


Air New Zealand - Domestic New Zealand Routes






Qantas – Domestic New Zealand Routes (December 2002)




Origin Pacific – Domestic New Zealand Routes




Air New Zealand Tasman coverage - Dec 02


Freedom Air – Trans Tasman Routes




Qantas – Trans Tasman Routes (December 2002)




Qantas – Trans-Tasman and New Zealand Domestic Routes (December 2002)




Qantas – Pacific Routes (December 2002)







Air New Zealand - Pacific Islands Routes
