

NOTIFICATION

To the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission:

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with sub-section 93(1) of the *Trade Practices Act* 1974, of particulars of conduct or of proposed conduct of a kind referred to in sub-section 47(6) or (7) of that Act in which the person giving notice engaged or proposes to engage.

1. (a) Name of person giving notice

Dell Computer Pty Limited (ACN 003 855 561) ("Dell")

(b) Short description of business carried on by that person

Dell supplies computer hardware and software products and peripherals directly to business and individual consumers.

2. (a) Description of the goods or services in relation to the supply or acquisition of which this notice refers

Various computer hardware and software products, storage and services and related products and services supplied by Dell including desktop computers, notebooks and servers ("Dell Products").

(b) Description of the conduct or proposed conduct

Dell proposes to enter into arrangements with Amercian Express pursuant to which Dell proposes to:

(a) supply or offer to supply to persons a Dell Product at a discount on the condition that the person uses a American

Express Business Card credit card to purchase the Dell Product;

- (b) refuse to supply or refuse to offer to supply to persons a Dell Product at a discount for the reason that the person has not acquired or used a American Express Business Card credit card to purchase the Dell Product;
- give or allow, or offer to give or allow, persons a discount, allowance, rebate or credit in relation to the supply of a Dell Product on the condition that the person uses a American Express Business Card credit card to purchase the Dell Product; or
- (d) refuse to give or allow a discount, allowance, rebate or credit in relation to the supply of a Dell Product to a person for the reason that the person has not acquired or used a American Express Business Card credit card to purchase the Dell product.

The amounts of the discount, allowance, credit or rebate offered by Dell will vary over time from product to product and model to model.

The proposed conduct will be of benefit to the public as it will:

- reduce costs to customers who may be otherwise unable to negotiate discounts, rebates, allowances, credits or other benefits in relation to the Dell Products on their own behalf;
- promote competition in the relevant markets by exerting downward pressure on prices offered by competitors, thereby encouraging competitors to offer similar discounts, rebates, allowances, credits and other value added services; and
- provide both businesses and individual consumers with the opportunity to obtain Dell Products at discounted rates.

The proposed conduct will not lessen competition in the markets for the relevant products and services and will be pro-competitive as:

- consumers will be able to acquire the same Dell Products at the usual price without the need to acquire any credit card services from American Express Business Card. Dell offers a range of payment options for its products, including cheque, cash, telegraphic transfer and Bankcard, Mastercard and VISA credit cards;
- competition in the computer hardware, software and associated services and credit card payment markets is vigorous and there are many competitors;
- consumers may acquire the relevant products and services from a range of other suppliers; and

consumers will be provided with a further incentive to purchase Dell Products, thus
increasing competition in the markets for computer hardware, software and associated
services.

The applicant believes that the likely benefits from the proposed conduct outlined above will outweigh any possible detriment considered to arise from the conduct.
