Third line forcing notification N70360 lodged by Caltex Australia Petroleum Pty Limited

I refer to the above third line forcing notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission on 19 May 2003. Legal immunity provided by the notification commences today, 30 May 2003.

Caltex Australia Petroleum Pty Limited proposes to enter into an agreement with AMIS Holdings Pty Limited (trading as Dewsons Supermarket Swanview) in which it will offer a discount of 2 cents per litre (or more) on petrol purchased by customers of Dewsons when they purchase products to the value of \$50 or more.

On the basis of the information that you have provided it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

Please note that the Commission may act to remove the immunity afforded by the notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.
