Exclusive dealing notification N91138 lodged by BP Broome Central Service Station

I refer to the above exclusive dealing (third line forcing) notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the Commission) on 15 July 2003. Legal immunity provided by the notification is due to commence on 29 July 2003.

You have described the conduct as customers of BP Broome Central Service Station being offered discounted fuel on condition that they purchase at least \$30 worth of groceries from Action Broome.

On the basis of the information that you have provided it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

As with any notification, please note that the Commission may act to remove the immunity afforded by this notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.
